About the Dwarf Minke Whale...

The dwarf minke whale is the smallest baleen whale, identified by about 50-70 throat grooves and has two blowholes, like all baleen whales. They can grow up to 8 metres long (not so small after all!) with adults weighing 5-6 tonnes.
